In response to the COVID 19 pandemic, triage and isolation measures have been implemented at Taiwan Mouse Clinic (TMC) to ensure a safe workplace. However, should a state of emergency be declared or the Biomedical Translation Research Center be forced to close, the following measures will be effective immediately to minimize laboratory animal housing.

1. Scheduled services will be postponed for two or more weeks.
2. If the animals have already arrived at TMC and the scheduled services have not yet been performed, two options will be offered: (a) the scheduled service will be postponed for two weeks and the additional cost of the mouse hotel will be absorbed by TMC. (b) Euthanasia will be conducted by TMC and all service fees will be credited to the next service.
3. If the scheduled services have commenced, three options will be offered: (a) If possible, the service will be postponed for two weeks and the additional cost of the mouse hotel will be absorbed by TMC. (b) If the service is scheduled to be finished on that day, euthanasia will be conducted after the completion of the service. (c) If the scheduled service cannot be completed on that day, euthanasia will be conducted by TMC. The service fee, less the portion of the completed service, will be credited to the next service.

TMC will do its best to maintain services during the COVID 19 pandemic. Nevertheless, unforeseen changes may occur and TMC appreciates the understanding and cooperation of our customers.
